April 16-22, 2018

The International Law Section of the State Bar of Texas is pleased to invite you to its upcoming CLE and visit to Buenos Aires and Mendoza, Argentina, on April 16 to 22.

Registration Fee: \$150 USD per person. The Fee covers the ILS's cost for a bilingual chaperone locally to help and guide the group during the trip. This fee does not cover any other expenses related to the trip. If this event does not sell-out prior, the cost will increase to \$250 per person on April 2nd.

Logistics: Each participant will be responsible for making his/her own hotel reservations, securing airfare, and for covering all of his/her costs, once in Argentina. Meals and fees for tours must be paid by each individual.

Cost of Trip: *Total trip cost estimate is estimated to be between \$3,000 USD (without the Mendoza Trip) and \$3,500 USD (including the Mendoza Trip). All costs estimates provided are per person. Each participant can decide which events he/she wishes to attend.*

MCLE Accreditation: This course has been accredited for 9.75 hours of MCLE credit, including one hour of ethics credit, in the State of Texas. (This includes 1 hour of CLE Credit for the additional day in Mendoza). Participants should enter their MCLE credit for whatever portion of the CLE accredited events that they attend. Attendees seeking credit in other States will be provided with a Uniform Certificate of Credit.
