CLE Committee

Throughout the year, this committee organizes in-person and online CLE events, including the **Annual Institute** and **Annual Meeting**. ILS members can participate in and contribute to planning these events.



Law School Engagement

ILS members with an interest in mentoring the next generation of international lawyers create programs and events in partnership with Texas law schools, students and professors.



Partnerships Committee

This committee pursues partnerships with law firms and other organizations to support ILS programs with in-kind and monetary sponsorships.



Membership Committee

ILS members help increase section membership among practicing Texas and international attorneys, law professors, legal assistants and law students by hosting **ILS Connect** networking mixers across the state, among other programs.



Media Committee

ILS members commit to regularly submitting articles for publication to our online newsletter, **Global Law Review**, or serving on the editorial board.

ILS members can also assist in producing segments for the **ILS Podcast** by identifying topics and speakers on timely and relevant international law topics, as well as serve as guest speakers and co-hosts.

Additionally, committee members can contribute ideas for social media messages and campaigns.



International Trips Committee

ILS Council members plan international trips for our members for cross-cultural exchange and to increase knowledge of foreign legal systems. In the past, the ILS has made trips to Havana, Cuba (2016); Panama City, Panama (2017); Buenos Aires, Argentina (2018); Mexico City, Mexico (2019); and Toronto, Canada (2020; cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic).

Upcoming proposed trips include a trip to The Hague in Spring 2027 to visit the Peace Palace, International Courts, and Arbitral Tribunals, with programming on international trade and dispute resolution.



International Human Rights Committee (IHRC)

Founded in August 2015, the IHRC represents a groundbreaking initiative in connecting business law with human rights advocacy. It emerged from recognition that lawyers needed better education and guidance on international human rights issues affecting their clients' global operations.

This committee oversees several programs and initiatives including an annual essay contest, annual Spring Symposium, and commemorates Human Rights Day (Dec. 10).
